Challenge Rules:



- **Theme It Up**: Design your game around an exciting theme—pirates, space, jungle, mystery... the choice is yours!
 - 2 Game Elements: Include player pieces, a game board, obstacles, rewards, action cards, and rules, etc.
 - **3 Innovate:** Use ALL the materials in the Mystery Kit in some way!
- **Test It:** Ensure your game is fun and works well with the rules you create.
- **Document the Magic:** Submit pictures of your game and pedagogical documentation that highlights:

How the game fosters creativity and teamwork.

The problem-solving skills involved in its creation.

How children might engage with or learn from your design.



Here's an amazing list of materials you can include in a mystery DIY board game challenge box. These items encourage creativity while being open-ended enough for kids to design their own unique games: (Optional)

Basic Materials:

- Cardstock or Heavy Paper For the game board base.
- Markers, Crayons, and Coloured Pencils For decorating the board and creating visuals.
- String or Yarn For designing pathways or creating obstacles.
- Scissors Child-safe ones for cutting materials into shapes.
- Glue Stick or Double-Sided Tape For assembling the game pieces and board.

Fun Additions:

- Mini Clothespins To clip on cards or as creative player markers.
- Stickers To decorate the board or create challenges (e.g., "land on the star sticker and lose a turn").
- Foam Sheets For making 3D elements or player tokens.
- Pom-Poms To represent game goals or obstacles.
- Pipe Cleaners To build unique pathways, fences, or figures.
- Cardboard Pieces Pre-cut shapes or small boxes to create 3D boards or dice.
- Envelopes For hiding "mystery clues" or instructions.
- Washable Paint or Ink Pads For creating unique designs or colourful stamps.

Themed Accessories (Optional):

- Foil Paper To make shiny treasure-like areas.
- Small Plastic Gems or Rocks To create rewards or treasures.
- Stamps and Stamp Pads To add symbols or design flair.
- Alphabet Stickers or Letter Tiles For word-related challenges or naming spaces.
- Optional Instructions to Include:
- Encourage kids to come up with a theme (e.g., space adventure, treasure hunt, or zoo escape).
- Provide guidelines like "Your game must have at least 3 rules" or "Incorporate a spinner."
